Chairman Mastrangelo called the meeting to order at 8:35 A.M.

IT – Servers and Storage \$135,000

This item has been brought back from last week requesting additional information.

Summary of options:

- ➤ Amazon Web Services migration [cloud] Proposal #019914 is \$57,304.00 and \$1,902.61 a month
- ➤ Data Center Upgrades [Deli VxRail hyperconverged solution] Proposal #019417 is \$96,441.00
- ➤ Data Center Upgrades [HP Simplivity hyperconverged solution Quote JJKD192 is \$126,365.82

Discussion followed on the above options.

Chairman Mastrangelo asked what the cost for backup is? Mr. Lomeland said that we got a new backup several years ago on site as well as schools that back up to each other. Administrator Guerino said he is concerned about the security of our data.

Mr. Lomeland suggest keeping in-house is better than out base in the cloud. Have security wall that we paid for several years ago.

Chairman Mastrangelo said there is a need to put significant amount of money into technology. It was also suggested that we get a sub-committee led by Mr. Lomeland to explore the comprehensive need for the servers and storage and come back for the Fall Special Town Meeting.

Mr. Lomeland said this is being brought up because the maintenance policy is to expire in March 2019 and can be renewed for 1 more year.

Administrator Guerino told Mr. Lomeland not to take this personally but we need to look into the whole package and see how it fits into the work he has done and that nobody is questioning his professionalism.

Recreation Keith Field Lights and Poles - \$165,000

George Sala thanked the committee for putting this on the agenda.

Request is to remove existing ballfield lights & poles and replace them with new lights and poles.

Keith Field is the only Senior Babe Ruth Field in town. Lights have to be replaced due to age [approximately 40 years] and for safety issues. Last inspection revealed that the lights and the bracket that hold the lights are badly corroded.

Keith Field is used 39 weeks of the years from March – November.

Mr. Sala spoke with Barry Johnson, Chairman of the CPC to see if they would pay 50% of the cost and would request 50% from Capital Outlay.

Requesting that Keith Field Lights and Poles be placed on the STM in the spring. Turnaround time after approval may lose 3-4 weeks of ball time but can be made up at the other end.

Administrator Guerino suggested using LED lights. Discussed LED lights vs HD lights. There is an additional \$85,000 added to the cost using LED lights. You can get 25 year warrant on LED lights vs. 10 years on HD lights. Need to weigh out the difference. Mr. Sala will check on LED lights that it may reduce the number of poles. Chairman Mastrangelo and Mr. Redman would personally go with the LED lights.

Original request was for \$165,000 from Capital Outlay and \$165,000 for CPC. Updated cost would be \$205,000 from Capital Outlay and \$205,000 from CPC

Useful life: 20 - 25 years

There is a 10 year warranty and Control-Link system for remote on / off and performance monitoring with 24/7 customer support.

Administrator Guerino said there is 1 more project the wants to discuss with the Capital Outlay Committee. Having a problem with stairs in front of Town Hall that are collapsing and handrails. Looking at ways to replace after the memorial was completed out front. Also looking at replacing the stairs outside the Town Administrator's office. Stairway is very steep.

Going to meet with Bracken Engineering to get a plan on elimination of part of the circle in front of Town Hall and adding more parking in area to the side of Town Hall. Grass area will know be primary parking increasing parking spaces by 20+. There will be no longer parking in front of Town Hall.

Chairman Mastrangelo said this will be a longer distance to walk to get into the building. Administrator Guerino said he will come back to Capital Outlay and don't have a problem waiting for fall.
