Best Buddies is a nonprofit 501(c)(3) organization dedicated to establishing a global volunteer movement that creates opportunities for one-to-one friendships, integrated employment and leadership development for people with intellectual and developmental disabilities (IDD).

The Best Buddies Challenge - Hyannis Port is a 100 mile long bicycle ride starting in Boston and finishing at Craigville Beach in Hyannis Port. We also have a 50 mile start in Carver and a 20 mile start in Sandwich. Through my involvement with this event over the last twenty years I recognize the support your communities offer to the safety of our ride. I have enclosed our route information regarding your community and we greatly appreciate your continued help. Police details are marked in the police column of the route notes and approximate times are noted on the right, as in the past, I will work with each department to hire the appropriate number of officers as we get closer to the event. The number of riders participating in this event has been approximately 250 at the 100 mile; 200 at the 50 mi. and 100 at the 20 mi. The cyclists will travel at their own pace; riders are required to wear helmets and abide by the rules of the road. We plan to follow all guidelines put in place by the CDC, state, city and other local agencies to keep everyone safe.
