A public information session on Phase 4 of the proposed Bourne Rail Trail project will take place at 6 p.m. on Wednesday, May 11, 2022.

The meeting will take place in the Bourne High School library.

The purpose of the session is to provide interested residents with an update on the status of planning for Phase 4 of the proposed pedestrian and bicycle pathway that would run along the existing state rail line.

The meeting will be hosted by the Town Administrator's Advisory Committee on Pedestrian Bicycle Pathway.

Phase 4 of the project extends south from Scraggy Neck Road in Cataumet to the current terminus of the Shining Sea Bikeway in Falmouth. An engineering firm retained by the towns of Bourne and Falmouth has prepared an initial 25% design for review by the state Department of Transportation.
