TOWN OF BOURNE DINGHY/KAYAK STORAGE POLICY

At a public hearing of the Board of Selectman held on November 1, 2022 the Board of Selectmen voted unanimously to amend and adopt the following policy on the use and storage of dinghies on Town of Bourne property.

DINGHY/KAYAK SEASON STORAGE REGULATIONS

FEE:

Dinghy Docks at Hen Cove, Barlows Landing, and Electric Ave are \$50.00 annually Dinghy Racks at Monument Beach, Pocasset River, and Electric Ave. are \$35.00 annually

Dinghy Dock at Monument Beach is \$100.00 annually Kayak Racks at Monument Beach, Barlows Landing, and Squeteague Harbor are \$35 annually

PERMIT STICKER:

A Permit Decal/Sticker shall be issued allowing the dinghy owner to use the town property including dinghy docks for seasonal storage.

RESTRICTIONS:

Dinghies kept at Town owned docks shall be limited to a (ten) 10-foot maximum length, kayak, canoe, SUP's 12-foot maximum length unless written permission is obtained from the Harbormaster. Dinghy/kayak racks shall have spaces assigned to permit holders.

The Permit Sticker shall be applied to the dinghy on the inside of the transom Port side, facing towards the bow. The Permit Sticker shall be visible while standing at the bow looking aft. It will be the responsibility of the dinghy owner to insure the sticker is attached and protected.

No dinghies/kayaks, canoes, and SUP's shall be stored on Town Property between October 31 and April 15 without written permission from the Harbormaster.

ENFORCEMENT:

1st Notice - Warning letter

2nd Notice – Civil citation & fine up to \$25/day

3rd Notice – Loss of dinghy storage privileges on town property

Abandoned vessels/non permitted storage fee of \$50 will be assessed to dinghies, kayak, canoe, and SUP's

DISPUTES:

Disputes shall be resolved by the Harbormaster.
