Everything looks pretty standard in accordance with abcc regulations. Is this something that the town has in place already and is revising, or is it an added layer of regulation? If so, what is the purpose of this? Is it to give selectman the same authority as abcc inspectors?

In section 1.07 D, it says “No licensee shall pay an employee any percentage of the profits of the business or pay an employee in any manner other than by salary or hourly rate, except upon approval of the Authority” Are you saying that an employer can’t do a profit sharing program with employees with out selectman approval? If so, it is a gross overstep of authority. A business, if they choose, should be able to bonus/share profits with employees as they see fit, not how the town sees fit. Thoughts, clarification? Thanks.
