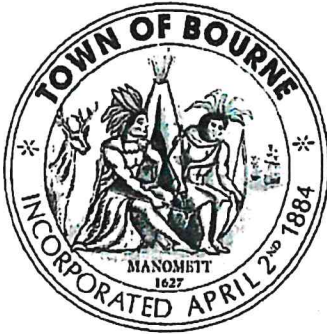
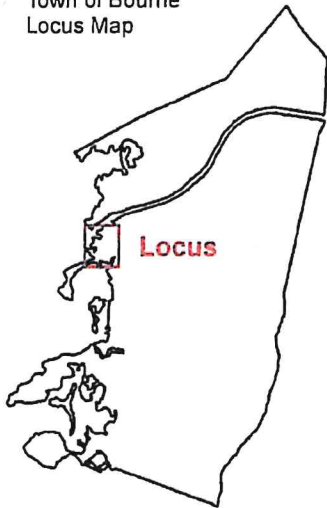

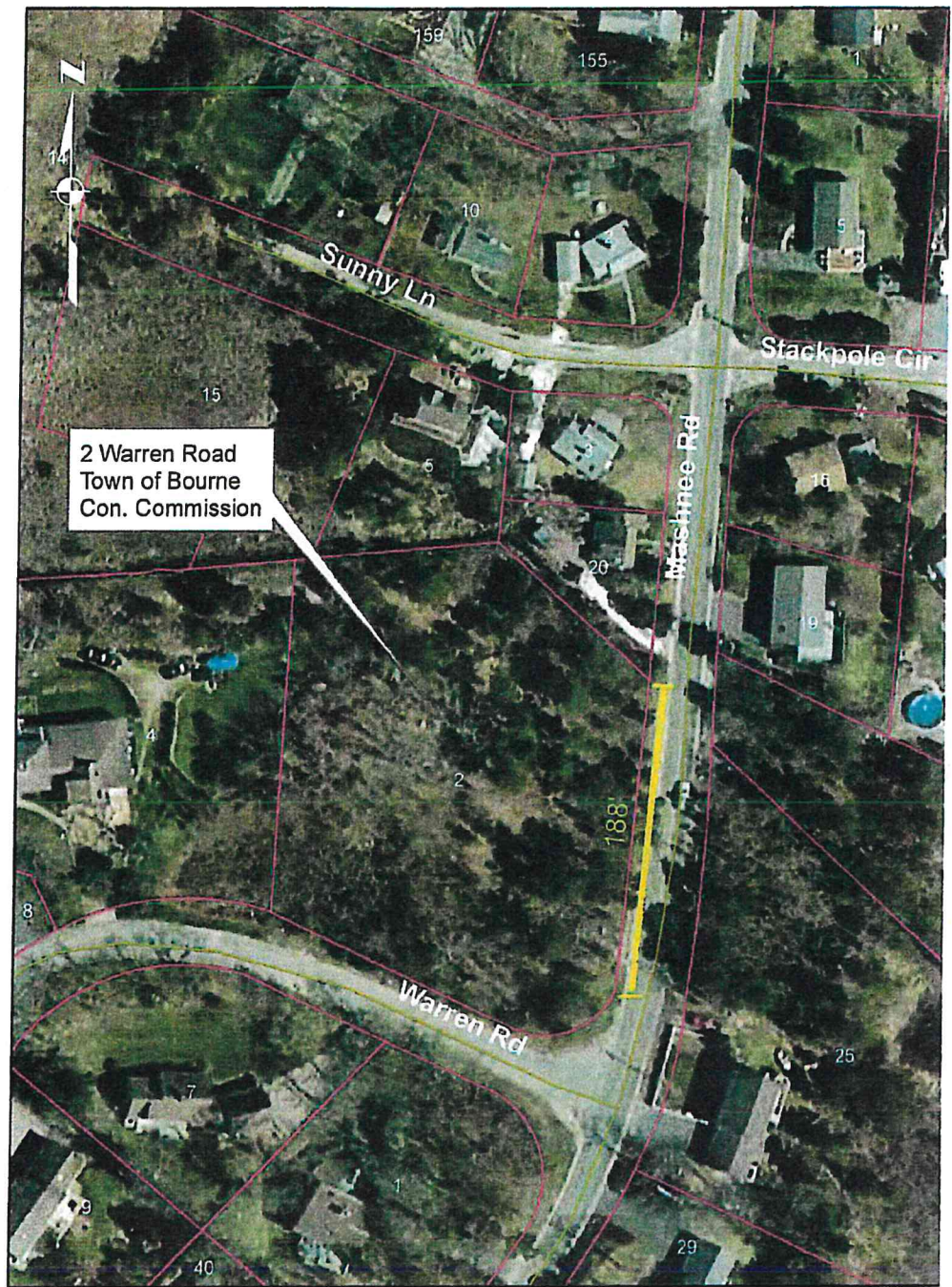


Town of Bourne
