Variances requested include a 10 foot reduction from the required 10 foot setback from the SAS to the property line at Tahanto Rd, a 3 foot reduction from the required 10 feet between a pump chamber and the property line at Pocahontas Rd, a 5 foot reduction from the required 25 feet between an SAS and a leaching catch basin, and a waiver to place the proposed septic tank and pump chamber within the required 10 feet from the existing water line.

Chapter 111, §31 and 310 CMR 11.02 to incorporate February 2023 updates from MassDEP's Drinking Water Program's Model BOH Regulations for Private Wells and Private Well Guidelines: CONTINUED from 4/27/2024.
