BOAT OCCUPANCY

BOARD OF HEALTH TOWN OF BOURNE

At a Board of Health meeting held on July 27, 1977, the following was voted as a health regulation relative to the occupying of boats and vessels:

No boat, houseboat, or other type of vessel shall be occupied within the waterways, inlets, channels or harbors of the Town of Bourne for more than 48 hours in any one calendar week unless such boat, houseboat, or other type of vessel is located at a marina with suitable sewage disposal or toilet facilities; and, further provided that the owner or occupant of such boat, houseboat, or other type vessel shall obtain prior approval from the Harbormaster to occupy such boat, houseboat, or other type vessel for up to a 48 hour period. The Harbormaster shall note the date, time, location of the vessel, and the number of occupants. The vessel shall have adequate on-board toilet facilities, as determined by the Harbormaster, to accommodate the number of persons to occupy during the 48 hour period. The above regulation will be enforced by the Harbormaster.
