

Residential Recycling Center Information

In addition to the curbside collection program, residents are encouraged to purchase a sticker for \$30, \$20 for seniors 60 and older, for access to the residential recycling center, which is located at 201 MacArthur Boulevard (Route 28 North). The residential recycling center is open 7 AM to 3 PM, seven days a week, except holidays, Memorial Day through Labor Day. After Labor Day it is closed Tuesdays during the off season. In addition to all the items accepted curbside, you can manage many other items for recycling or disposal as listed in the box below or bring items for reuse at the ever popular Dorothy's Swap Shop. Newspapers, magazines, catalogs, phone books, office paper, facial tissue boxes, cardboard, chipboard, wrapping paper, paper bags, paper tubes, file folders, clean pizza boxes, milk cartons, cereal boxes and juice cartons.



PLASTIC CONTAINERS #1-#7

(Do not crush and keep lids on)
Soda bottles, water bottles, laundry detergent bottles, milk jugs, yogurt tubs, deli tubs, drink cups, plant pots.



METAL CONTAINERS

Tin cans, aluminum cans, clean aluminum foil, pie plates, metal lids.



GLASS CONTAINERS

Loose glass bottles and jugs.

- Use of these carts is required for curbside collection. Plastic trash bags can be used for your trash. Do not put recyclables into plastic bags.
- Recyclables and trash must fit into each container with the lid closed. No separate bags or barrels may be set out for collection.
- Recycling is mandatory in Bourne.
- Failure to comply may lead to termination of curbside collection service.
- Carts must be at the curbside no later than 7 AM the day of collection and not out before 5 PM the night before.
- Carts remain the property of the Town but residents are responsible for their care. Report all product damage or malfunctions to the DPW for servicing.
