LEGAL NOTICE

At a Board of Health meeting held on July 27, 1977, the following was voted as health regulations for roadside stands and mobile units:

A. Roadside Stands

- 1. Must have toilet facilities within a distance of fifty feet.
- 2. Must have potable water available on site.
- 3. Shade must be provided for eatables offered for sale.
- 4. All perishables shall be stored on the premises under proper refrigeration to prevent spoilage.
- Proper containers shall be provided for fruits and vegetables that have decomposed.
- 6. All stands shall be set back thirty (30) feet from the edge of a roadway, highway, street, or other route of vehicular traffic.

B. Shellfish

- The sale of fish or shellfish shall be governed by the Rules and Regulations for the Sanitary Control of the Shellfish Industry, Rules and Regulations relative to fish and fish products.
- 2. Shellfish must be maintained under proper refrigeration at all times and kept in containers which are sanitary and protected from the direct rays of the sun and other elements conductive to spoilage or contamination.
- Ferson must get an application from the Division of Marine Fisheries and an inspection by the Mass. Public Health Dept., Food and Drug, 100 Cambridge Street, Boston, MA (727 - 3193).

C. Mobile Units

 Must conform to the same regulations when utilized as a road stand.
