


For a town this size, this small library is doing a great job. Would really like the town behind renovations and expanding.


The staff is very helpful and the online accessibility is great for reading the latest publications. The building however is embarrassing.



**Before** The Pandemic How Frequently Did You Visit The Bourne Library Or Use Our Digital Services




We need a Branch Library on the Buzzards Bay/Sagamore side of the bridge

Workshops on how to download books and explaining other access to other online services. These workshops should occur multiple times per year.


Better website. It really needs updating.

Sandwich library is so bright and cheery now and I like the artwork too. Old building with a modern twist.


