Ropes & Hoses—Nope!

Tanglers, such as garden hoses, rope, wire, and even plastic bags, are extremely hazardous to put into recycling. These items can catch in the equipment and cause major

damage to it, create danger and safety hazards for workers, or could even shut down a recycling facility.
