

Below are the results from the survey.


Question 1: What is your Age?


Question 2: Currently, what would you consider yourself? *multiple answers allowed


Question 3: What Courts do you utilize the most? *multiple answers allowed


Question 4: How many times have you played on Bourne Courts, in last year?




Question 6: Of the four layouts, preference is...?




2 white lined tennis courts over 6 orange lined blue filled pickleball courts

Question 7: Any comments, suggestions or other feedback?

There is one tennis court at Barlows/Pocasset and 4 yellow pb courts. The tennis court runs East to west, the pb courts run north to south which is preferred. I can't understand how another tennis court and 2 more pb courts can fit there. Is there a plan to enlarge the existing footprint to accommodate it? Also why not do pb lines in yellow not orange.? Nowhere have I seen any measurements of the proposed courts so how would one know how "legal" they will be? My option would be to put down the tennis court first and add the pb lines second going north to south with legal measurements for both.

What are the layout options for a single tennis court and four pickleball courts like at Pocasset?

Multi-colored looks too complicated and possibly an issue for those who might be color challenged.

I agree court maintenance and resurfacing is necessary. I don't like the idea of one group ruling over the other. Seems like the pickle ball players have the say while they aren't year round residents.

Very happy that Bourne has appropriated money to fix the courts.

I prefer Opinion D. But I suggest the pickleball courts be lined with orange paint. Can not have the Tennis and pickleball lines painted the same color. Thank you.

The Clark Road tennis courts need to be resurfaced. Do to the dampness of the last few years the surface of the court have become extremely slippery and has developed a mold type film on the surface. This developing slippery surface along with the preexisting cracks in the surface makes these courts susceptible to personal injuries. Thank you.

Why can't Monument beach courts be added to be repaired. The town keeps on providing pickleball lessons etc...Why not provide permanent courts like Mashpee and Sandwich.

Thank you for soliciting input. I would like to see dedicated pickleball courts with fixed nets, Maybe option D with two fixed net pickle pall courts in blue with orange lines and next to it a tennis court with white lines and 2 pickle ball courts with orange lines to bring your own nets.

No mention of nets. Different heights for nets

It may be time to commit to several sets of pickleball-only courts around Bourne with permanent nets. Mashpee has a successful model to consider.

All options are valid and useable. it will be impossible to please everyone. The most important thing is that the resurfacing is completed.

Whichever layout is done depending on the size of the courts for pickleball players a blue court with white lines is what works best.

Please fill cracks first and add toilet

Please fill the large cracks prior to this. Also add porta potty, but please consider fencing between tennis nets like forges field. Thank you
